SVENHOLM was built as a 38 feet cruiser/racer in 1954 by the shipyard Heidtmann in Hamburg/Germany and launched at that time as "Hobby". She was part of a series of ten boats, which were built at Heidtmanns yard for German and American customers, and they all were called the "S&S Lokis", designed by Olin Stephens in 1947 (Design 619: two boats "Loki" and "Chance"), 1953/54 (Design 1001: 12 boats including SVENHOLM).

SVENHOLM was basically reconstructed in 1994 with new planking (3 layers 4mm mahogany using vacuum process), decks, floors, keel bolts, s-steel ring frame, rigging, interiors, all technical installation and sails. She is very well equipped for family cruising and racing and is offered in impressive condition. This is a rare chance to acquire a stunning classic yacht with this special piece of pedigree and also a colourful and complete history. **Price:** € 135.000,-- Her home port is the Baltic Sea (Schleswig Fjord) in Germany.
